Adopt-A-Precinct Volunteers Raise Thousands

Sumter County's Adopt-A-Precinct participants have raised about \$39,000 — and they're only halfway done. The statewide initiative allows organizations to staff polling locations and have their wages donated to charitable causes. During the August primary, 13 organizations participated in Sumter's program. Hometown Civitan was the only group that worked early voting. "It's a rewarding experience because we get to meet the public and guide them through the process while we're there," said Mary Anderson, president. All 13 organizations will return for the November election.
